EXAMINATION REQUESTED:

Items N, O, P, and Q consist of a computer, software and manuals; request they be examined to determine if information regarding victims and activities of suspect are contained within.

Request all items except N, O, P, and Q be examined for the presence of blood, hair, fiber, skin tissue, drugs, gunshot residue and any other trace evidence you deem appropriate.

Items CA, CB, and CC were obtained from the suspect, Jeffrey L. Dahmer, and are being provided as standards for comparison with any hair, blood, or fluid evidence obtained. Additionally, request that Item CA be examined and the International Blood Grouping and Alternate Blood Groupings be established.

Item A, Item C, Item D, E, F, G, H, be compared with markings on Items BM, BQ, BQ, and BZ.

Request that the molars contained in Items BR, BS, BT, BU, BV, BW, and BX, be examined in an attempt to determine the blood groupings of the victims and determine their international blood and alternate blood groupings. They are further supplied for comparison to any question blood evidence determined to be on the items within this transmittal.

Request that Item AJ, a small drill bit, be compared with the holes in the sample of skulls in Items BQ, BR, BS, and BV.

Request that Items BL, BN, BP, BY, be examined for the presence of sexual assault evidence to include blood, semen, and any other trace evidence you deem appropriate. If found, determine typing classifications and secretor, non-secretor determination.

Items CD, CE, and CF contain polaroid photos taken by the suspect of victims; request that these photos be examined and if possible, enhanced to further the identification of the suspect and victims.

THE FOLLOWING IS A DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE VARIOUS PERSONS WHO HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED IN THE INVESTIGATION WHICH INVOLVES THE ARREST OF JEFFREY DAHMER. THE FOLLOWING IS A LIST OF THE 11-VICTIMS WHO HAVE NOW BEEN "POSITIVELY" IDENTIFIED.

#1., Oliver LACY, B/M, dob: 6-23-67, of 3237 N. 24th Pl. He has been missing since July 12, 1991, and was reported missing on July 15, 1991, by his fiancé. He was identified through his fingerprints which were obtained from severed hands which had been tagged by the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner as "hands A". His complete skeletal remains have now been identified as belonging to him, Medical Examiner's #1501. He has no Milwaukee Police Department I.D. number. He has a State of Illinois I.D. #26952750. His mother was notified of his death on July 24, 1991, at 10:00 A.M., and was assigned homicide #M2472. The identification was made by Milwaukee Police Department Bureau of Identification.

#2., Matt TURNER, B/M, dob: 7-3-70, a/k/a Donald MONTRELL, of Chicago, Illinois. He was not reported missing to our department. His identification was found in DAHMER's apartment. He was identified through fingerprints by the Chicago Police Department AFIS machine, and confirmed by the Milwaukee Police Department, Bureau of Identification. The identification was made from severed hands tagged by the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner as "hands C". He has no Milwaukee Police Department I.D. number. He has a Chicago Police Department I.D. #928806. His complete skeletal remains have been identified as belonging to him. His father was notified of his death on July 25, 1991, at 8:30 A.M. by the Chicago Police Department, and he was assigned homicide #M2473.

#3., Jeremiah WEINBERGER, W/M, dob: 9-29-67, of 3404 N. Halsted, Chicago, ILL. WEINBERGER was reported missing by his father on July 6, 1991 to the Chicago

Police Department. His identification was also found in SAHNER's apartment.

b7c WEINBERGER was identified by [REDACTED] through dental records. His complete skeletal remains have been identified as belonging to him.

WEINBERGER's father was notified of his death on July 25, 1991, by the Chicago Police Department. He was assigned Milwaukee Police Department file #M2474.

#4., Joseph BRADEHOFT, W/M, dob: 1-24-66, of 1144 E. Kane Pl., Milwaukee, WI. He had been reported missing to the Greenville, ILL. Police Department prior to moving to Milwaukee to live with his brother. He had not been reported missing to the Milwaukee Police Department. He was last seen in Minneapolis, MINN., on June 4, 1991, by his ex-wife, and she states she spoke to him on July 4, 1991, via the telephone, but doesn't know where he was calling from. He was identified through fingerprints by the Milwaukee Police Department. Comparison fingerprints were supplied by the St. Paul Minnesota, Police Department. The identification was made from severed hands which were tagged by the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner's office as "hands B". We have a complete skeletal remain of Joseph BRADEHOFT identified. Joseph BRADEHOFT was assigned homicide file #M2475.

b7c #5., Anthony HUGHES, B/M, dob: 8-26-59, of 211 S. Carol St., Madison, WI. He was reported missing to the Madison, WI. Police Department on May 31, 1991, and last seen May 24, 1991, when he was seen by a friend at the "219-Club", 219 S. 2nd St. He was identified by [REDACTED] through dental records. He was assigned Milwaukee Police Department homicide #M2476. We have recovered Mr. HUGHES skull and vertebra. His mother was notified of his death on July 5, 1991, at 2:50 P.M. He has no police I.D. number that we are aware of.

#6., Konerak SINTHASOMPHONE, A/M, dob: 12-2-76, of 2634 N. 56th St., Milwaukee, WI. He was reported to the Milwaukee, WI. Police Department on May 28, 1991, and

b7c was last seen on May 26, 1991. He was identified by [REDACTED] through dental records. He was assigned Milwaukee Police Department homicide #M2477. He has no police I.D. number that is known of. His parents were notified of his death on July 25, 1991 at 6:05 P.M., and we have recovered the skull and vertebra of KONGERAK SINTHASOMPHONE.

#7. Raymond Lamont SMITH, B/M, dob: 8-10-57, a/k/a Ricky Lee BEEKS, a/k/a "Cash D". His identification was also found in DAHMER's apartment. Interview of family members indicates he was living in Milwaukee and last seen about one year ago. He was not reported missing to any police department that we are aware of. He has Milwaukee Police Department I.D. #209157. He was identified through dental records by [REDACTED] and was assigned Milwaukee Police Department homicide #M2478. His grandmother was notified of his death on July 25, 1991, at 10:00 P.M. We have recovered and identified the skull of BEEKS.

b7c #8. Curtis STRAUGHTER, B/M, dob: 4-16-73, of 3628 N. 19th St., Milwaukee, WI. He was last seen at home by his grandmother on February 18, 1991. He had not been reported missing until [REDACTED] interviewed her on July 24, 1991. He has our I.D. #231279. He was identified by [REDACTED] through dental records. The family was notified of his death on July 26, 1991, and his case was assigned homicide #M2479. We have recovered the skull of Curtis STRAUGHTER.

b7c #9. Errol LINDSEY, B/M, dob: 3-3-72, of 1119 A. N. 24th Pl. He was last seen on April 7, 1991, and reported missing to our department by his sister on April 11, 1991. Errol LINDSEY has a Milwaukee Police Department I.D. #220831. He was identified by [REDACTED] through dental records. His mother was notified of his death on July 26, 1991, and his case was assigned Milwaukee Police Department homicide #M2480. We have recovered the skull of Errol LINDSEY.

#10. Anthony SEARS, B/M, dob: 1-28-65, of 1557 N. Astor, #7. He was last seen at home on March 25, 1989, at 9:30 A.M., and reported missing to the Milwaukee Police Department by his friend on March 29, 1989. He has Milwaukee Police Department I.D. #207455. He was identified by [REDACTED] through dental records, and his parents were notified of his death on July 26, 1991. He is believed to have been murdered at *Rem* [REDACTED] West Allis, WI., at his grandmother's home. (West Allis, WI. case). He has not been assigned a homicide case number at this time. We have recovered and identified the skull of Anthony SEARS. Through the interview of the suspect we have also been able to identify the scalp and penis which were recovered at DAHMER's apartment as belonging to Anthony SEARS.

#11. Ernest MILLER, B/M, dob: 5-5-67, of Chicago, ILL., who was in Milwaukee visiting relatives. He was last seen leaving a friend's home at [REDACTED] at 1:30 A.M., on September 3, 1990, and was reported missing to the Milwaukee Police Department by relatives on September 4, 1990. He has no I.D. number that we are aware of. He was identified by [REDACTED] through dental records. His parents were notified of his death on July 26, 1991, at 8:30 A.M., and his case was assigned Milwaukee homicide case #M2482. We have recovered the skull of Ernest MILLER.

At this time, all body parts recovered at DAHMER's apartment have been identified.

THE FOLLOWING PERSON IS ALSO BELIEVED TO BE A VICTIM OF JEFFREY DAHMER. DAHMER STATES THAT HE DID KILL HIM AT HIS APARTMENT AT 924 N. 25TH ST., #213, AND STATES THAT HE DESTROYED ALL OF HIS REMAINS.

HIS INFORMATION HAS NOT BEEN RELEASED TO THE PRESS.

Edward W. SMITH, B/M, dob: 8-2-52, of 3606 N. 11th St., missing since June 23, 1990, and reported missing the same date. He has not been assigned a homicide case number at this time. No notification of next-of-kin has been made. Verification of this case is still pending.

UPDATED LIST OF DAHMER'S HOMICIDE VICTIMS

RE: Edward Smith is now being identified as victim #12. His family was notified of his death on 7/29/91 at 9:30P.M. His information has been released to the press.

Victim #13: David C. Thomas, B/M, DOB: 12/21/67, of 6432 W. Birch St., Milwaukee. Reported missing to the Milwaukee Police Department on 9/24/90. He was identified by the suspect as a victim in this offense. A photo of the deceased after his death was found in the apartment. David Thomas has a Milwaukee Police Department BOI #200484. A sister of the victim was notified of his death on 7/29/91 at 7:35P.M. There are no remains. He was assigned Homicide Case M2484.

Victim #14: Richard Guerrero, H/M, DOB: 12/12/65, of 3332 N. 1st St. Reported missing to the Milwaukee Police Department on 3/29/88. He was identified by the suspect as being a victim in these series of homicides. He is our Milwaukee Police Department BOI #190872. This homicide occurred in the City of West Allis at the home of the suspect's, DAHMER, grandmother and there are no remains.

Result of examination:

HAIRS AND FIBERS EXAMINATIONS:

Negroid head hairs and hair fragments suitable for significant comparison purposes, and Negroid and Caucasian hairs not suitable for significant comparison purposes were found on specimens Q4, Q9, Q11, Q13 and Q28 (10812064). No hairs which were suitable for significant comparison purposes

exhibit the same microscopic characteristics as those in the known head hair samples from Oliver Lacy (K1 - 10812064), Joseph Bradehoff (K1 - 10813026), Jeremiah Weinberger (K1 - 10813027), Anthony Sears (K2 - 10813031), or Matt Turner (K1 - 10813036).

No hairs microscopically like those in the known head or pubic hair samples from the suspect (K5 and K6 - 10812064) were found on or in specimens Q47 through Q49 (10812064), Q5 (10813026), Q1 (10813031), Q1 (10813034), or Q5 and Q6 (10813036).

SEROLOGY/DNA EXAMINATIONS:

10812064:

Grouping tests conducted on the known samples disclosed the results set forth below.

K3	(LACY)	"Hp 1"
K4	(DAHMER)	"PGM 1+, Hp 2-1, Gc 2-1S"

All additional grouping tests conducted on specimen K3 were inconclusive. Grouping tests conducted on the K2 saliva sample were inconclusive.

Grouping tests conducted on human blood identified on specimens Q18, Q30, Q31 and Q34 through Q42 were inconclusive. Human blood, insufficient in quantity to allow further analysis, was identified on specimens Q1, Q14 and Q19. Human blood, which was not further characterized, was identified in specimens Q46 and Q47. Blood which could not be further characterized was identified on specimen Q33. Stains containing human protein, but no blood, were identified on specimen Q29. No blood was identified on specimens Q1A, Q2 through Q11, Q20 through Q23, Q32, Q43 through Q45 and Q51 through Q53.

Both human blood and semen were identified on specimens Q50 and K2. Semen was also identified on specimens Q51 and Q52. No semen was identified on specimens Q14 and Q53.

Biochemical testing for substances characteristically present in fecal matter were positive on samples taken from specimens Q29, Q32 and Q61.

10813026:

Grouping tests conducted on the K3 bone marrow sample and the K2 saliva sample were inconclusive.

Human blood was identified on specimens Q1 and K2. Chemical tests for the possible presence of blood were positive on specimens Q2 through Q4. In view of the nature of the specimens, no further examination was conducted for blood.

Specimens Q1 through Q4 and K2 were examined for the presence of semen, however, none was identified.

10813027:

Grouping tests conducted on the K3 bone marrow sample from WEINBERGER disclosed the results set forth below.

K3 "Hp 1, Gc 1S"

All additional grouping tests conducted on this specimen and on K2 were inconclusive.

Human blood which was not further characterized was identified on specimens Q1 and K2. Chemical tests for the possible presence of blood were positive on specimens Q2 through Q6, however, in view of the nature of the specimens, no further characterization was done.

Specimens Q1 through Q6 and K2 were examined for the presence of semen, however, none was identified.

10813036:

Grouping tests conducted on the K3 bone marrow sample and the K2 saliva sample were inconclusive.

Human blood was identified on specimen K2. Chemical tests for the possible presence of blood were positive on specimens Q1 through Q4. In view of the nature of the specimens, no further characterization was conducted on these specimens.

Specimens Q1 through Q4 and K2 were examined for the presence of semen, however, none was identified.

Additional laboratory examinations to determine DNA profiles in samples taken from the submitted evidence are currently in progress. You will be advised of the results of these examinations by separate report. If any developments occur in this case such as dismissal of charges or guilty pleas which would eliminate the necessity for conducting these examinations, please advise the FBI Laboratory DNA Analysis Unit immediately (202-324-5436).

TOOLMARK EXAMINATIONS:

Specimen Q6 (10813036) contains longitudinal impressions that are consistent with a sawing action, that left no toolmarks of value for identification purposes and thus could not be associated with any of the submitted saw blades.

Specimen Q7 (10813036) contains longitudinal impressions that are consistent with a reciprocating (back and forth) sawing action that left no toolmarks of value for identification purposes.

Specimen Q1 (10813029) has two holes that are consistent in diameter with Q28 (10812064) and therefore could have been produced by this drill bit. However, due to a lack sufficient corresponding toolmarks of value, no further association could be made. Additionally, holes in Q1 (10813028), Q1 (10813033) and another hole in Q1 (10813029) vary in diameter from 1/8th-1/4th of an inch in size. These holes also have no toolmarks of value for identification purposes.

There are no toolmarks of value for identification purposes present on any of the other items submitted in this case.

No further associations could be made with any of the other submitted tools and the submitted items in this case.

CHEMISTRY EXAMINATIONS:

Specimens Q2 and Q14 are negative for the presence of commonly encountered drugs.

PAINT EXAMINATIONS:

The paints from the Q1 (Laboratory number 10813030), Q2 (Laboratory number 10813031) and Q1 (Laboratory number 10813032) specimens were examined microscopically.

microchemically and instrumentally. Based upon the comparison examinations conducted, these paints were determined to match in colors, textures, type and composition. Therefore, it was concluded that these paints could have originated from a common source.

The probable source of the above-described paints is a commercially available product called FLECK STONE in their "Gotham Gray" color. FLECK STONE is manufactured by the PLASTI-KOTE Company, Medina, Ohio, 44256, and can be found in both hardware and craft stores. The above-mentioned paints matched the "Gotham Gray" FLECK STONE in color, texture, type and composition.

PHOTOGRAPHIC EXAMINATIONS:

The Q1 polaroid photograph (10813035), Q2 polaroid photograph (10813030) and the Q10 polaroid photograph (10813027) were photographically copied and enlargements made.

It was determined the Q1 and Q2 film were manufactured in April 1990 and the Q10 film was manufactured in November 1990. No determination can be made as to exactly when the photographs were taken.

The photographic enlargements are being returned separately. The copy negatives are being retained at the FBI Laboratory.

MAGNETIC MEDIA EXAMINATIONS:

The Q57 harddisk drive, Q58a through Q58i, Q60, and Q60a floppy disks were analyzed using the computer resources currently available to the FBI Laboratory.

Directory listings have been produced for Q57, Q58a through Q58i, Q60 and Q60a.

The Q57 harddisk drive C: contained only software programs. No data files except those provided by software manufacturers were located. The hidden files are either MS-DOS operating system files or programs related to the commercial software package Pctools manufactured by Central Point Software. One deleted file was located on Q57 in the C:\directory. This is a system configuration file.

A disk dump of drive C: showing all the printable characters has been produced.

The Q57 drive D: did not contain any program or data files. No hidden or deleted files were located on D:.

Upon receipt in the FBI Laboratory, the Q57 Myoda laptop computer system would not boot up. The computer system was taken to PKI/MYODA 1053 Shore Road, Naperville, IL 60563 on September 11, 1991 for repair. The motherboard was replaced in the Q57 computer system. During the repair process some Pctools' files that are used to monitor the system's configuration were duplicated. This is a normal occurrence when this option is chosen from within the Pctools software package.

The Q58a through Q58i, Q60 and Q60a floppy disks contain software program files for Pctools and Microsoft Learning Dos. No data, hidden or deleted files were located on these disks.

Q57, Q58a through Q58i, Q60 and Q60a floppy disks, Q59, manuals, hardcopy printouts, old memory board and motherboard are being returned along with the other evidence to the contributor.

No duplicate diskcopies or hardcopy printouts are being retained by the FBI Laboratory.

All specimens are being maintained at the FBI Laboratory until picked up by a representative of your department.

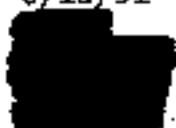

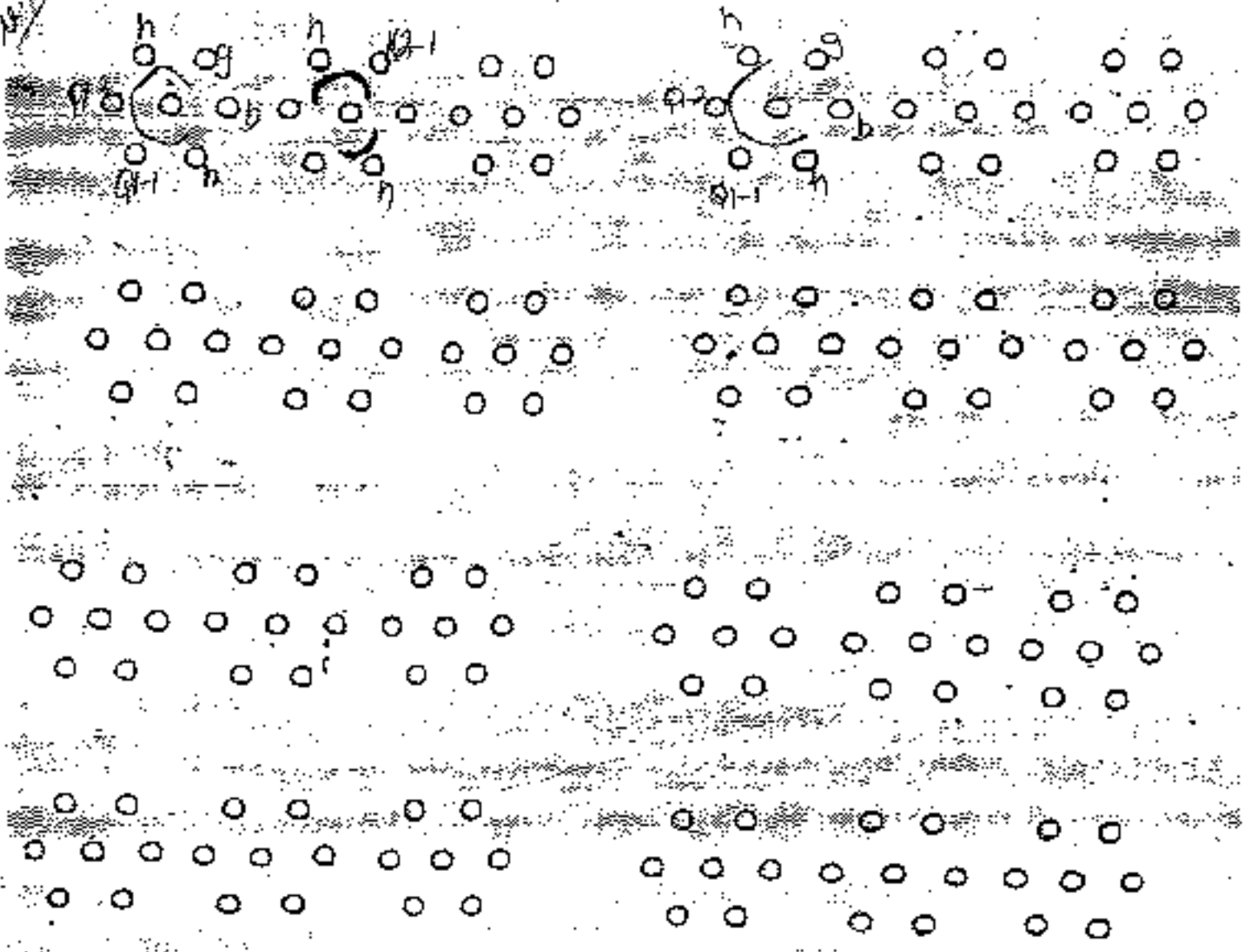

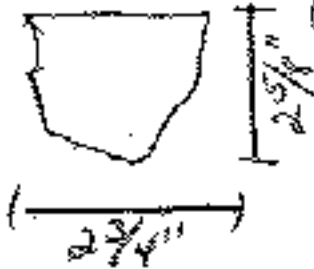

determination could not be made in this case with respect to the comparison of DNA profiles from specimens Q50, K2 and K4; however, the source of the specimen K4 (JEFFREY DAHMER) could not be excluded as a contributor to the DNA profiles obtained from specimens Q50 and K2 (DNA profiles obtained from specimen K2 are from intact spermatozoa). DNA profiles obtained from specimens Q13 and Q28 did not match DNA profiles from specimen K4 and did not originate from the source of specimen K4. Although no conclusive DNA profile results were obtained from specimen K3 (bone marrow sample from LACY), OLIVER LACY probably did not contribute to the DNA profiles from specimens Q13 and Q28.

Although DNA profiles obtained from specimen K3 (a bone marrow sample from JEREMIAH WEINBERGER listed under FBI Laboratory number 10813027 S/D ZJ QW QF TL YI) did not give DNA profiles suitable for conclusive matching purposes, JEREMIAH WEINBERGER can be excluded as being a contributor to the DNA profiles obtained from specimens Q13 and Q28. No DNA profile results were obtained from specimen Q52 due to the presence of insufficient and/or degraded DNA.

No DNA profile results of value for significant comparison purposes were obtained from specimen K3 due to the presence of insufficient and/or degraded DNA. No DNA examinations were conducted with specimens K1 and K2.

10813027:

No conclusive DNA profile results were obtained from specimen K3 due to the presence of insufficient and/or degraded DNA. No DNA examinations were conducted with specimens K1 and K2.

REFERENCED TELETYPE, MIAMI RECEIVED INFORMATION FROM [REDACTED] THAT THREE SEPARATE WITNESSES HAVE COME FORTH AND HAVE PLACED DAHMER AT THE HOLLYWOOD SHOPPING CENTER THE MORNING

ADAM WALSH WAS KIDNAPPED FROM A SEARS DEPARTMENT STORE.

[REDACTED] DESCRIBED HIS WITNESSES AS BEING RELIABLE ORDINARY CITIZENS AND NOT INDIVIDUALS SEEKING NOTORIETY OR PUBLICITY. *b7c*

ONE OF THE WITNESSES IS A [REDACTED] IN THE FORT LAUDERDALE AREA AND LIKE THE OTHER TWO, AFTER SEEING DAHMER ON THE NEWS THEY INDEPENDENTLY CONTACTED [REDACTED] AT DIFFERENT TIME FRAMES. THERE IS NO INFORMATION TO REFLECT THAT THE WITNESSES KNOW EACH OTHER.

WITH THIS INFORMATION MIAMI AGREED TO ASSIST [REDACTED] IN ATTEMPTING TO SECURE A PERSONAL INTERVIEW WITH DAHMER. WITH ASSISTANCE FROM SA [REDACTED] SSA [REDACTED] HAS BEEN IN TELEPHONIC CONTACT WITH DAHMER'S ATTORNEY JERRY BOYLE ON NUMEROUS OCCASIONS. BOYLE WAS PRESENTED WITH THE NEWEST DEVELOPMENTS IN THE WALSH CASE AND AGREED TO ASSIST IF IT MEANT NOT PLACING HIS CLIENT IN JEOPARDY. AS THE BUREAU AND MILWAUKEE ARE AWARE DAHMER HAS REFUSED TO IMPLICATE HIMSELF IN CASES IN THOSE STATES WHICH CARRY THE DEATH PENALTY. *b7c*

ATTORNEY BOYLE REFUSED TO ALLOW THE MIAMI CASE AGENT AND

[REDACTED] TO INTERVIEW HIS CLIENT PRIOR TO DAHMER'S TRIAL. HE INDICATED THAT DAHMER HAD INFORMATION (POSSIBLY AN ALIBI) THAT WOULD ELIMINATE HIM AS A SUSPECT IN THE WALSH CASES. HOWEVER, THIS INFORMATION WAS NEVER SHARED WITH MIAMI, SSA [REDACTED] b7c [REDACTED] ATTEMPTED TO OBTAIN THIS INFORMATION JUST PRIOR TO DAHMER'S TRIAL, BUT BOYLE DID NOT MAKE HIMSELF AVAILABLE AND REFUSED TO RETURN TELEPHONE CALLS LEAVING MESSAGES WITH HIS SECRETARY THAT AFTER THE TRIAL HE WOULD CONTACT THE MIAMI CASE AGENT.

THE LAST TELEPHONIC CONTACT WITH BOYLE OCCURRED ON THURSDAY, APRIL 16, 1992, WHEN SSA [REDACTED] CONTACTED HIM AT HIS RESIDENCE. DURING THIS TELEPHONE CONVERSATION, BOYLE b7c INDICATED THAT DAHMER HAS RETAINED AN ATTORNEY FROM PHILADELPHIA, ROBERT MOZENTER (PHONETIC) TO APPEAL THE CASE. BOYLE DID NOT APPEAR EAGER TO DISCUSS THE CASE.

IN ONE OF THE ABOVE REFERENCED CONVERSATIONS WITH SA [REDACTED] HE INDICATED THAT DAHMER HAD BECOME FRIENDLY WITH ONE OF THE DETECTIVES FROM THE MILWAUKEE POLICE DEPARTMENT. MIAMI b7c WOULD STILL LIKE TO INTERVIEW DAHMER SINCE HE IS CURRENTLY THE ONLY SUSPECT IN THE CASE. IF MILWAUKEE THROUGH THE LOCAL
