
ORDER REMOVING SEAL

NOW, on this 19th day of May, 2005, the Court, at the request of the State of Kansas and defendant, orders the removal of the protective order of seal on the probable cause affidavit.


The protective order of seal dated March 2, 2005 was sought by the parties as an additional protection against disclosure of sensitive information that would impact the State's compelling interest in obtaining just convictions and the defendant's right to a fair trial. The Court with full knowledge of the contents of the affidavit and in consideration of the defendant's right to a fair trial and the State's compelling interest in obtaining just convictions granted the request of the parties to seal the affidavit.

The affidavit in support of probable cause is unavailable for examination pursuant to K.S.A. 22-2302(2).


